Protect Girls from Invasive Verification Exams

It requires invasive proof just to play.

Girls, and only girls, would need a signed statement verifying anatomy, genetics, or hormone levels before joining a school sports team.

It targets everyone to reach almost no one.

Over 200,000 WA girls play school sports; fewer than 1% are estimated to be transgender, yet all would face new scrutiny.

It hits Black, brown, rural, and low-income girls hardest.

Families without a long-term doctor able to certify sex from years of history face the steepest, most expensive barriers.

Courts have struck down laws like it before.

A near-identical Idaho law was ruled unconstitutional sex discrimination in *Hecox v. Little* (2020).
